

HOW Collaborative HSNZ Clinical Fellowship for 2020

The Haematology Society of Australia and New Zealand (HSANZ) Council is pleased to call for applications for the **HOW Collaborative HSNZ Clinical Fellowship** to be taken up in 2020.

This year, the HOW Collaborative and HSNZ will award one Clinical Fellowship to an Australian or New Zealand applicant of outstanding merit and whose work aligns with the aims of the HOW Collaborative and HSNZ.

HOW Collaborative HSNZ Clinical Fellowship Value

The HOW Collaborative Clinical Fellowship is funded to a total value \$60,000 for a period of one year only. The HOW Collaborative Clinical Fellowship must be taken up in 2020.

HOW Collaborative Research Priorities

- Focus on optimising outcomes in haematology and obstetrics or women health.
- Alignment with HOW Collaborative vision and strategy.
- Clinical benefit from research.
- Research outcome within 12 months.
- If purely research: should be enrolled in higher degree.
- May be able to combine research with clinical role.

HOW Collaborative HSNZ Clinical Fellowship Eligibility

1. Applicants must be in the final year or within 5 years of completing advanced training in either Haematology, Obstetrics, Anaesthetics or Obstetric Medicine.
2. Able to take up the HOW Collaborative Clinical Fellowship in 2020.
3. Australian or New Zealand residents.
4. Be members or trainee members of HSNZ and the How Collaborative.
5. Willing to present a report to the membership of HSNZ at the National Scientific Meeting: Blood after the completion of their Clinical Fellowship.
6. Willing to attend the award presentation at the Blood 2020 Gala Dinner in Perth, 22 October 2019.
7. Applicants may only receive one PhD scholarship or Clinical Fellowship during their lifetime.

HOW Collaborative HSA NZ

Clinical Fellowship for 2020

Applications must contain a:

1. Fellowship proposal including Research Project (5 pages maximum including references).
2. CV of applicant (3 pages maximum).
3. Statement of how the proposed Fellowship relates the aims and objectives of the HOW Collaborative. (1 page maximum).
4. Statement of how the proposed Fellowship relates to the promotion of Haematology practice and the aims and objectives of the Haematology Society of Australia and New Zealand. (1 page maximum).
5. Written reference from a referee familiar with the applicant's recent work history (1 page maximum).
6. Fellowship supervisor report to confirm supervision arrangements for the proposal. The report should also comment on the suitability of the applicant for the fellowship and likelihood for successful completion of the fellowship project within the proposed time period.

Application Procedure

1. Applications must be accompanied by all relevant documentation.
2. Applications must be submitted in full by the **5pm on the closing date**.
3. Applicants will submit two copies of their scholarship application:
 - a. one printed and posted to the HSA NZ Office, and
 - b. one electronic (pdf) emailed to HSA NZ Office.
4. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
5. Applications will be subject to review by the HSA NZ Council and the HOW Collaborative.
6. The outcome of applications will be announced mid-September 2019.
7. HSA NZ and the HOW Collaborative reserve the right to not award the Fellowship.
